## *Entry Procedures*

1. Participants are encouraged to submit their entries online.
2. **Early Bird Entry Deadline: June 19<sup>th</sup>, 2026. Entries will be accepted after this date at the Late Entry Fee.**
3. Entries will be considered valid only when the Edgerton Agricultural Society receives a completed Entry Form, including payment in full.
4. The Edgerton Agricultural Society reserves the right to refuse any entry fee without further liability.
5. Entries that have been entered incorrectly may, after discussion with the Exhibitor, may be transferred to their proper class.
6. A rider may change their horse up to the start of the show. The Secretary must be informed.
7. **Entry fee will be refunded only upon receipt of a medical certificate or veterinary certificate prior to the first class of the show. Refunds will be mailed out after the show.**
8. All participants will be required to sign a waiver of liability, for minors their guardian must sign.

### **Rules for All Participants.**

1. All Horse show participants and attendees must purchase a gate pass, this pass gets you a free pancake breakfast on Sunday.
2. Dogs must be kept on a leash.
3. Any exhibitor who uses contemptuous or abusive language to another exhibitor, Volunteer, Member of the Edgerton Agricultural Society or the public shall forfeit the right to participate in the equine events. Abusive language and behavior shall not be tolerated on the Edgerton Sports Grounds.
4. Please clean up after yourself, your horse and fill in any holes your horse may have dug.
5. If necessary, please ensure your horse has an appropriate ribbon in their tail (red, green or blue etc.)
6. At this time the Edgerton Sports Grounds does not have any stabling, exhibitors will need to bring their own panels, electric fence or tie their horse to their trailer.
7. You will need to bring your own horse feed, manure fork, manure bucket&/or wheel barrow, feed & water buckets. There will be water available on site.
8. There will be no washing station available for your horse, there will be water available you can bucket to wash your horse.
9. The organizing committee reserves the right to correct errors or make alterations to the rules &/or prize list when deemed necessary.
10. This event will go ahead rain or shine. Please be aware of the weather and be prepared for both you and your equine partner.
11. NO Stallions.
12. NO stabling horses in the Bull pens.
13. There will be 2 show rings going simultaneously. Ring A will be in the Bullarama area and Ring B will be on the track. See image below.
14. Entry fee will be refunded only upon receipt of a medical certificate or veterinary certificate prior to the first class of the show. Refunds will be mailed out after the show.
15. Exhibitors are requested to read all rules governing the show. If you have an issue, please bring it to the attention of the Show Secretary.
16. Any exhibitor/participant who violates any of the Rules and Regulations printed in the Competition Book will forfeit all privileges and premiums upon the decision of the Show Committee. This may include forfeiting prizes/awards, prize money, all passes/entry fees.

*STATEMENT OF PRINCIPLES The abuse or inhumane treatment of a horse by an exhibitor, trainer or other people at this competition shall not be tolerated under any circumstances. The competition organizing committee has the right to ask the participant to leave and forfeit any entry fees.*

*Liability:* The Edgerton Agricultural Society or the Show Committee Volunteers will not be responsible for damage, injury, loss or theft irrespective of the cause of such damage, injury, loss or theft. Each exhibitor will be solely responsible for any loss, injury, or damage done to, administered by or arising from any animal or exhibitor negligence. This shall indemnify the Edgerton Agricultural Society against all legal or other proceedings regarded thereto.

### ***RV Parking/Horse Trailer Parking***

Camping is allowed on site. The back portion, south of the track, is for horse show participants. There is no power or water hookups in this area. When parking please park in an orderly fashion as to use the space available wisely.

Just a reminder, there are no stalls for horses; please bring your own panels, electric fence or tie your horse to your trailer.
