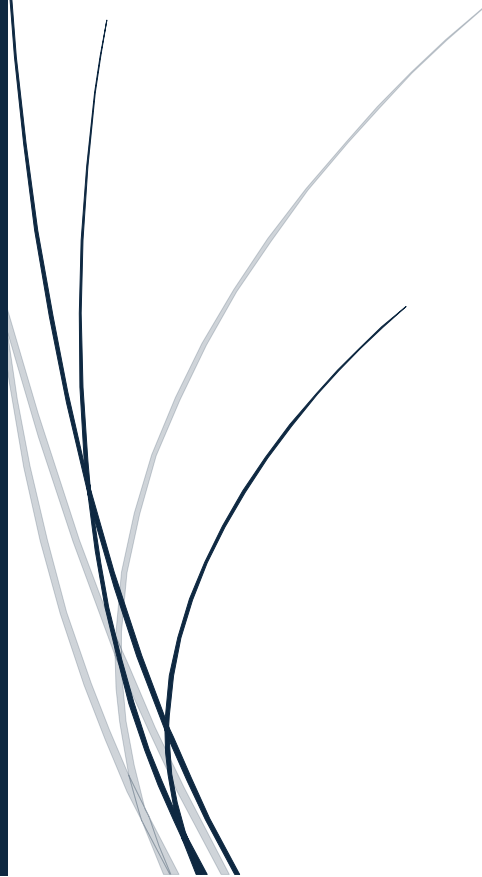

## Barrel Racing (unsanctioned jackpot.)

**Saturday, July 4th & Sunday, July 5th – Ring B (on the track)**

**Event starts at 2:30 pm on Saturday & 1:30 pm on Sunday (or after gymkhana)**

### Rules

1. We are hosting a 2-day event – one run on Saturday and one run on Sunday.
2. Contestants may enter more than one horse with the entry fees being paid on each. Prizes will be awarded to the horse/rider combination.
3. The fastest penalty free time in the Open, Youth, and Pee Wee will determine the divisions within the age group.
4. Knocked Barrel equals No Time.
5. Not following the clover-leaf pattern will receive a no time. A broken pattern shall be defined as breaking the forward motion to retrace their tracks to finish the pattern and/or passing the plane of the barrel on the offside. Example: Should a contestant run by a barrel and must back up or turn around and retrace their tracks, this would be considered a broken pattern.
6. The decision of the timer will be final.
7. Pattern will be measured and marked prior to the jackpot.
8. Organizers will have rakes, harrows and an arena groomer on site. Ground will be raked every 4<sup>th</sup> rider. And the harrows run over the ground as needed, based on the number of participants.
9. Organizers will do their best to schedule riders with multiple horses with enough time in between.
10. If only one horse places in a division that horse shall receive the entire payout for that division.
11. Any horse not under control may be asked to leave the arena and be disqualified from further classes. (entry fee will be forfeited)
12. A horse may be ridden by more than one person in the youth & pee wee classes so long as neither contestant is showing any other horse in the same class. In no case will the same horse be run more than twice in the same class and three times in the same jackpot. No horse may be ridden by more than one person in the open division.
13. In the case that there are no times for a Division, the prize money will be split between the other Divisions.

#### Category Ages: (ages as of July 4<sup>th</sup>)

- Peewee – 9 and under
- Youth – 10 – 15
- Open 16+

#### Early Bird Entry Fee (register before June 20<sup>th</sup>)

- \$20 Pee Wee
- \$20 Youth
- \$30 Open

#### After June 20<sup>th</sup>

- \$25 Pee Wee
- \$25 Youth
- \$35 Open

*All Entry Fees will be paid out!*

**\$5 per horse administration fee on top of entry fee.**

Divisions will be defined as follows:

3 Divisions (1 second split)

1D = fastest time of the day & all times faster than the 2D fast time.

2D – fastest time 'plus one second' & all times faster than the 3D fast time.

3D = fastest time 'plus two seconds' & all times below the 3D fast time

### Payout

- The number of entries per age category will determine the prize money for that category.
- Each age category - prize money will be divided as follows:

### OPEN

1D – 50% of prize money from the OPEN entries - 1<sup>st</sup> - 50%, 2<sup>nd</sup> – 30%, 3<sup>rd</sup> – 20%

2D – 30% of prize money from the OPEN entries - 1<sup>st</sup> - 50%, 2<sup>nd</sup> – 30%, 3<sup>rd</sup> – 20%

3D – 20% of prize money from the OPEN entries - 1<sup>st</sup> - 50%, 2<sup>nd</sup> – 30%, 3<sup>rd</sup> – 20%

For example: if there are 10 riders in open that is \$300 in entry fees.

1D pot will be \$150 and split as follows – 1<sup>st</sup> - \$75, 2<sup>nd</sup> - \$45 & 3<sup>rd</sup> - \$30

2D pot will be \$90 and split as follows – 1<sup>st</sup> - \$45, 2<sup>nd</sup> - \$27 & 3<sup>rd</sup> - \$18

3D pot will be \$60 and split as follows – 1<sup>st</sup> - \$30, 2<sup>nd</sup> - \$18 & 3<sup>rd</sup> - \$12
