PARADE RULES

Please read and acknowledge your acceptance of the following:

- Adequate supervision of all children participating in the Parade must be provided.
- Children riding on floats will be supervised by an adult.
- Riders may not mount or dismount the float or tow vehicle when it is in motion.
- Riders may not stand, jump, dance or dangle any body part over the edge when the float is in motion.
- Rider seats must be secured to the float deck. For maximum protection it is recommended a guardrail barrier should be erected along the exposed sides and ends of platforms to prevent falls of persons out of the float.
- The float driver must be an 18+ Adult with a valid Driver's License and at least one 16 years or older passenger side spotter. Our goal is simply to ensure nobody is hurt by falling of a float.
- While travelling along the route, participants must do their best to keep up with the float in front of them. No stopping is allowed along the route to ensure even flow from the first float to the last without any gaps or a disruption in flow of parade traffic.
- For safety purposes, candy and/or promotional items MUST BE HANDED OUT. DO NOT THROW ITEMS FROM YOUR VEHICLE. As per our insurance requirements, throwing of candy or items is NOT ALLOWED.
- Any animals prior to or during the parade being seen as acting erratically will be asked to exit the parade route. Anyone bringing an animal must ensure they have appropriate insurance to participate.
- For large vehicles (semi, tractor) it is recommended that two spotters either inside the vehicle or walking are required.
- Livestock participants under the age of 16 are required to wear proper protective helmets.
- Livestock participants must ensure they have appropriate insurance to participate.
- Off Road Vehicles (OHVs) must arrange/provide insurance.
- Any motor vehicle that qualifies as per Alberta legislation must have valid insurance.
- The driver must keep both hands on the wheel the entire parade. No use of cell phones or cameras etc. All distracted driving and provincial safety laws still apply.

INSURANCE DOCUMENTATION

In order to ensure safety for all participants, the driver/vehicle operator; <u>upon request</u>; must show proof of valid **Insurance & Valid Driver's License**





EXCLUSION OF LIABILITY ASSUMPTION OF RISK

As a condition of participation in the Edgerton Parade July 6TH, 2024; I/we the participant (participant also refers to any participating group) assume all risk of personal injury, death or property loss; resulting from any cause whatsoever including but not limited to the negligence, breach of contract, or breach of statutory duty of care on the part of the Village of Edgerton, the Edgerton Agricultural Society and their Directors, Officers, Volunteers, Employees, Agents, Representatives, or Sponsors, (herein collectively referred to as the "Parade Operators"). The Participant agrees that the Parade Operators shall not be liable for any such personal injury, death or property loss however caused and release the Parade Operators and waives all claims with respect thereto. The Participant agrees that any litigation involving the Parade Operators shall be brought solely within the Province of Alberta. The Participant further agrees that these conditions and any rights, duties, obligations as between the Parade Operators and the Participant shall be governed by the interpreted solely in accordance with the laws of the Province of Alberta and no other jurisdiction.

LEGAL HOLDING HARMLESS AND INDEMITY CLAUSE

By completing and signing this agreement and participating in the Edgerton Parade on July 6th 2024, I/we further agree I/we will save harmless and indemnify the Village of Edgerton, the Edgerton Agricultural Society and their Directors, Officers, Volunteers, Employees, Agents, Representatives, or Sponsors, from any and all liabilities and claims which may occur from my participating in the Edgerton Parade on July 6th, 2024; however caused.
